- Branding/tattoos (names, numbers, dollar signs, emblems @ neck, chest, wrist, fingers, lower
- Adult is speaking for youth and is controlling the conversation
- Youth has no ID, or doesn't have control of ID or other important documents, or has fake ID
- Youth is fearful or submissive (looks at ground, not speaking, doesn't know location, looks at adult before answering questions)
- Past or current homelessness
- Genital injuries, STI's
- Prior pregnancies and/or abortions
- Urinary tract infections/difficulties
- Hypervigilant, angry, or displays unwarranted paranoia/fear
- Bruises in various stages of healing
- Scars, mutilations, or infections
- Signs of drug abuse or symptoms of drug withdrawal
- □ Malnutrition/dehydration

Human Trafficking Quick Indicator Tool - Health Care

If youth:

- Is advertised social media/internet,
- Was brought in unconscious,
- Was recovered from a hotel,
- Evidence of implantation of chip (raised area) on neck behind earlobe, web area between thumb and forefinger, or inside of lower forearm,
- Admits exchanging sex/sex acts for money/ goods, or
- Has had a prolonged absence from home without explanation/consistently runs away from home for >24 hours call DCS immediately. Indiana DCS: 1-800-800-5556

Other Red Flags
The factors on the reverse side may also indicate human trafficking. You must use your professional judgment based on the individual circumstances to determine if DCS should be notified. If you see 3 or more of these factors, it is recommended you call the DCS hotline at (800) 800-5556 to initiate a human trafficking assessment.
